## 32 Week Visit

The physician will perform another ultrasound. This ultrasound is not routinely performed by most Ob/Gyn practices. This ultrasound is to ensure normal growth. Our practice does not bill nor get paid for this ultrasound. Although we will attempt to get a 4-D picture for you, the baby may be in a poor position to obtain a good picture. If this is the case the sonogram will not be repeated. There is no additional charge to you for this ultrasound.

Please make sure your phone does not have privacy directory or call block. If you have a medical emergency, and the doctor is calling from a phone with an unlisted number, then he won't be able to return your call. The answering service will inform you to proceed to the emergency room without the doctor being able to speak to you.

Sharp pains in the abdomen and groin are very common at this point. They are more common with sudden movements. The ligaments that hold the uterus in place stretch as the baby grows and causes the pain. It is completely normal.
