39 Week Visit

At this visit we will measure the fundal height (the size of the baby) and check your baby's heartbeat. Be sure to write any questions down on a piece of paper and bring it to the visit. We may also perform a vaginal examination to see if your cervix has dilated.

Please make sure your phone doesn't have privacy directory or call block. If you have a medical emergency, and the doctor is calling from a phone with an unlisted number, then he won't be able to return your call. The answering service will inform you to proceed to the emergency room without the doctor being able to speak to you.
